Guest speakers were Scott Miller (House of Esau) who shared about his research and work with post-abortive men. Scott had additional speaking opportunities while he was in town – with Adult & Teen Challenge and the Christian Professionals and Businessmen's Association. Nicole Scheidl, Executive Director from Canadian Physicians for Life gave an informative presentation regarding the challenges to conscience rights facing our Canadian medical professionals. Nicole also met with a number of local health care professionals while in town.



"Gosnell: The Trial of America's Biggest Serial Killer" is based on the true story of Kermit Gosnell, an American physician and former abortion provider who murdered newborn babies and committed numerous other crimes. It recently became one of the first politically controversial movies to be screened at The White House. It is one of the most successfully crowd-funded films in history with almost 30,000 people donating over \$2.3 million dollars in 45 days to enable the film to be made and the story told. The film ranked in the top 10 at the box office when it was released in theatres and was the No. 1 best selling drama DVD on Amazon during its pre-release sales.
