Sasha took part in activism projects including: Post-Carding (delivering pro-life literature door to door), Door-Knocking (going door-to-door speaking to people in-person about abortion), Choice Chain & Vehicle Choice Chain (using abortion victim photos to expose the reality of abortion and create opportunities for discourse with members of the public). Sasha shared the following about his experience:

"It was hard but extremely valuable work! Canadian youth have a huge role to play in the fight for the lives of the pre-born. I learned how to use pro-life apologetics to have effective conversations with people about abortion.
